INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY

Medford Soccer's policy for inclement weather is as follows:

1. All practices and games are to be played as scheduled unless field conditions are determined to be unsafe for the players, coaches, referee(s) and spectators. The responsibility for the determination of field safety lies exclusively with Medford Soccer's Town Coordinator or the referee on the field at game time. Coaches, parents and players have no role in the decision to cancel a game due to weather; it is up to the Medford Soccer Town Coordinator and the referee.
2. In the event of severe or prolonged inclement weather, Medford Soccer's Town Coordinator will inspect each field for standing water, mud and other unsafe conditions. Medford Soccer's President, 1st Vice President and 2nd Vice president may coordinate these inspections with the Town Coordinator.
 - Based on the conditions observed on the field and the weather forecast, the Medford Soccer Town Coordinator will close the field until further notice if unsafe conditions are present. Once closed, the field(s) will remain closed for the remainder of the day.
3. Field closures will be posted to (i) the Medford Soccer website; (ii) Medford Soccer's hotline and (iii) MYSL's Referee website. Unless notice is placed on one or more of these sites, coaches and players are expected to arrive at their assigned field ready to play. Teams that do not wait for an official determination before departing the field or fail to appear risk forfeiting the game.
4. The referee can make a final determination on field conditions just prior to a game or at any time during the game. If the referee determines that field conditions are unsafe and cannot support play without undue risk of injury to the players, the game will be suspended.
